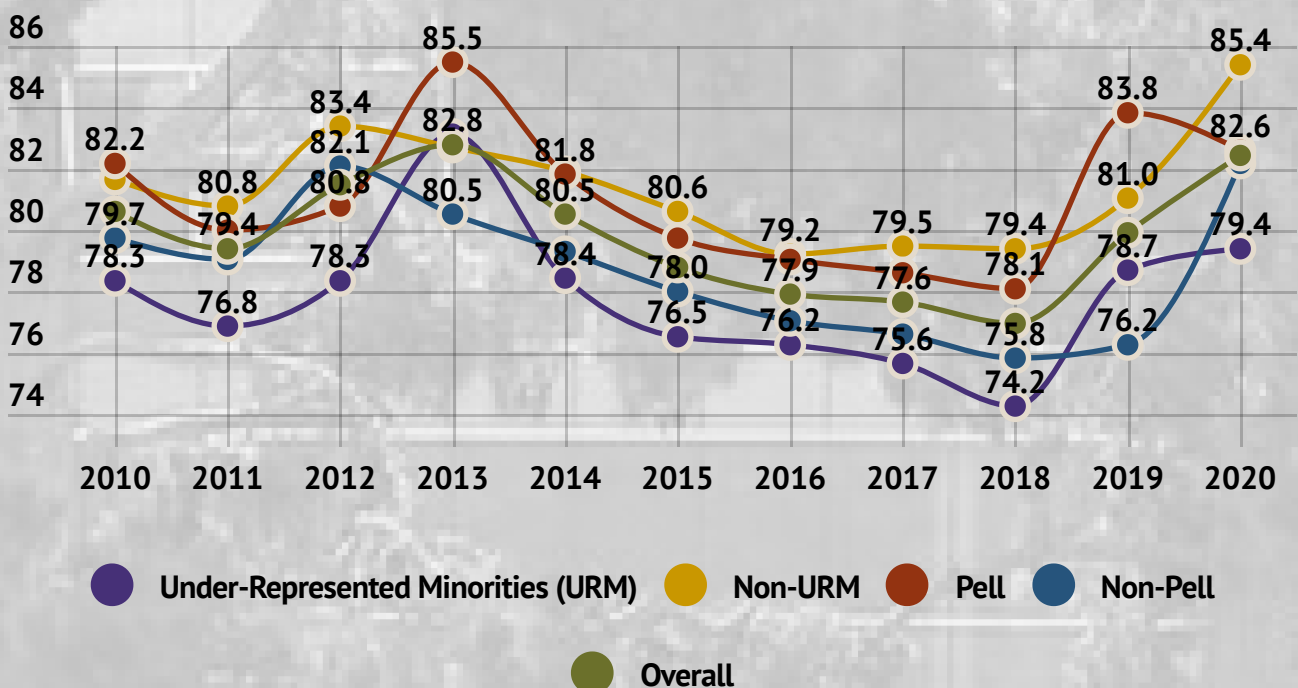

(Fall 2010-Fall 2020)

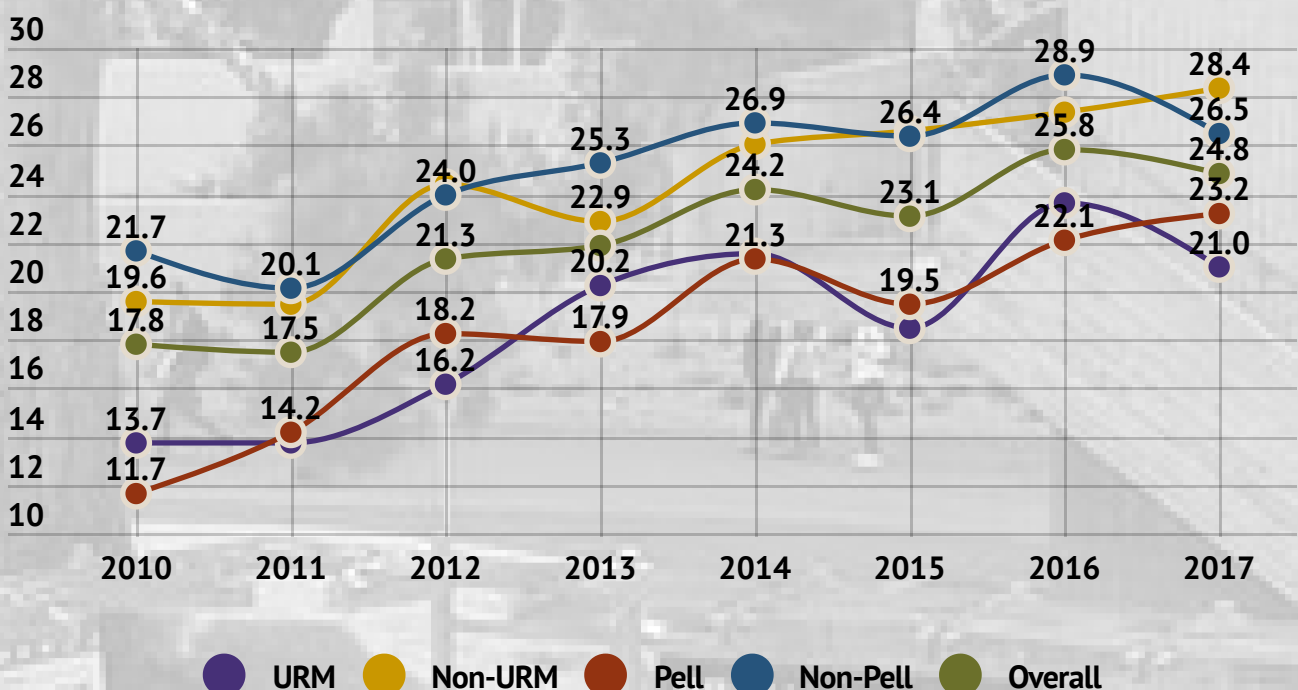


Line chart for First-Time Freshmen 1st year retention rates over time, Fall 2010-Fall 2020.

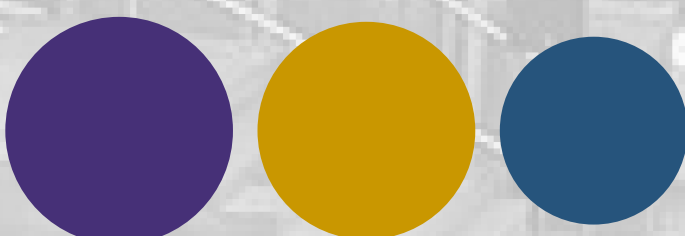

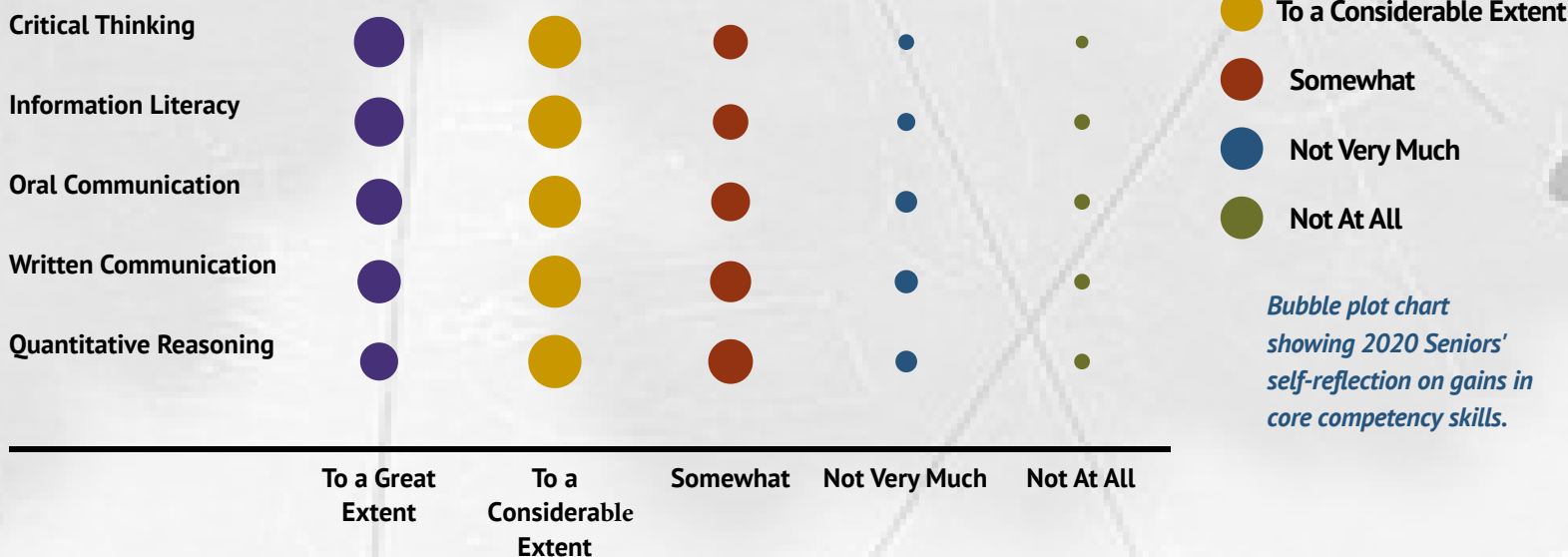

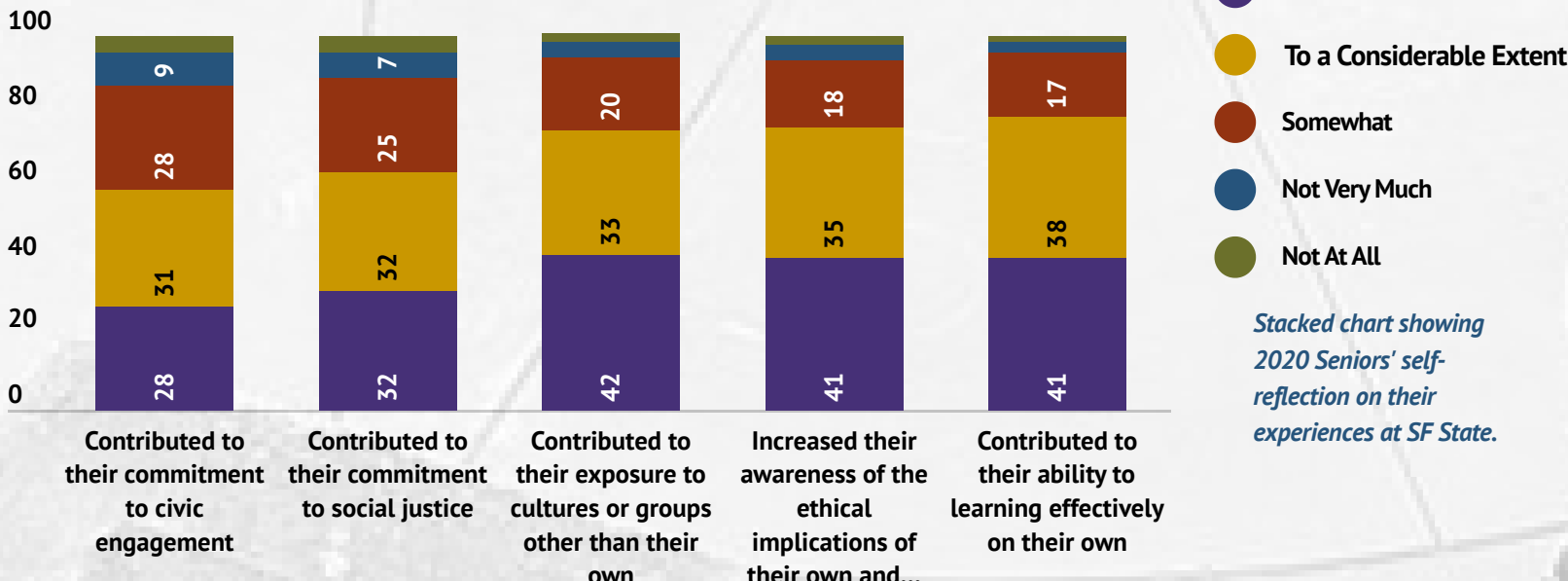
