Accept admission offer

1 Students entering SF State in Fall 2019 may accept their admission offer and pay a \$100 non-refundable enrollment confirmation deposit (ECD), which is applied to the first semester tuition fees now through May 1, 2019, in their Student Center portal at gateway.sfsu.edu. For help setting up your portal, visit registrar.sfsu/passwordhelp.

Students admitted after May 1 must accept their offer within two weeks of their admission date.



Sign up for orientation and register for classes

2 Freshmen and transfer students who sign up for orientation receive early advising and course registration.

Space is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis. Visit newstudentprograms.sfsu.edu for more information.

Submit proof of immunization

Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) and Hepatitis B (HEP-B)

3 Proof of immunization is required to register for classes. Submit proof to the Registrar's Office.



Check financial aid award status

4 In your Student Center portal, check your financial aid award status and complete any items on your "to do list" to ensure SF State can award you all financial aid for which you are eligible. Also, check your Cal Grant status at mygrantinfo.csac.ca.gov and verify San Francisco State University is listed.

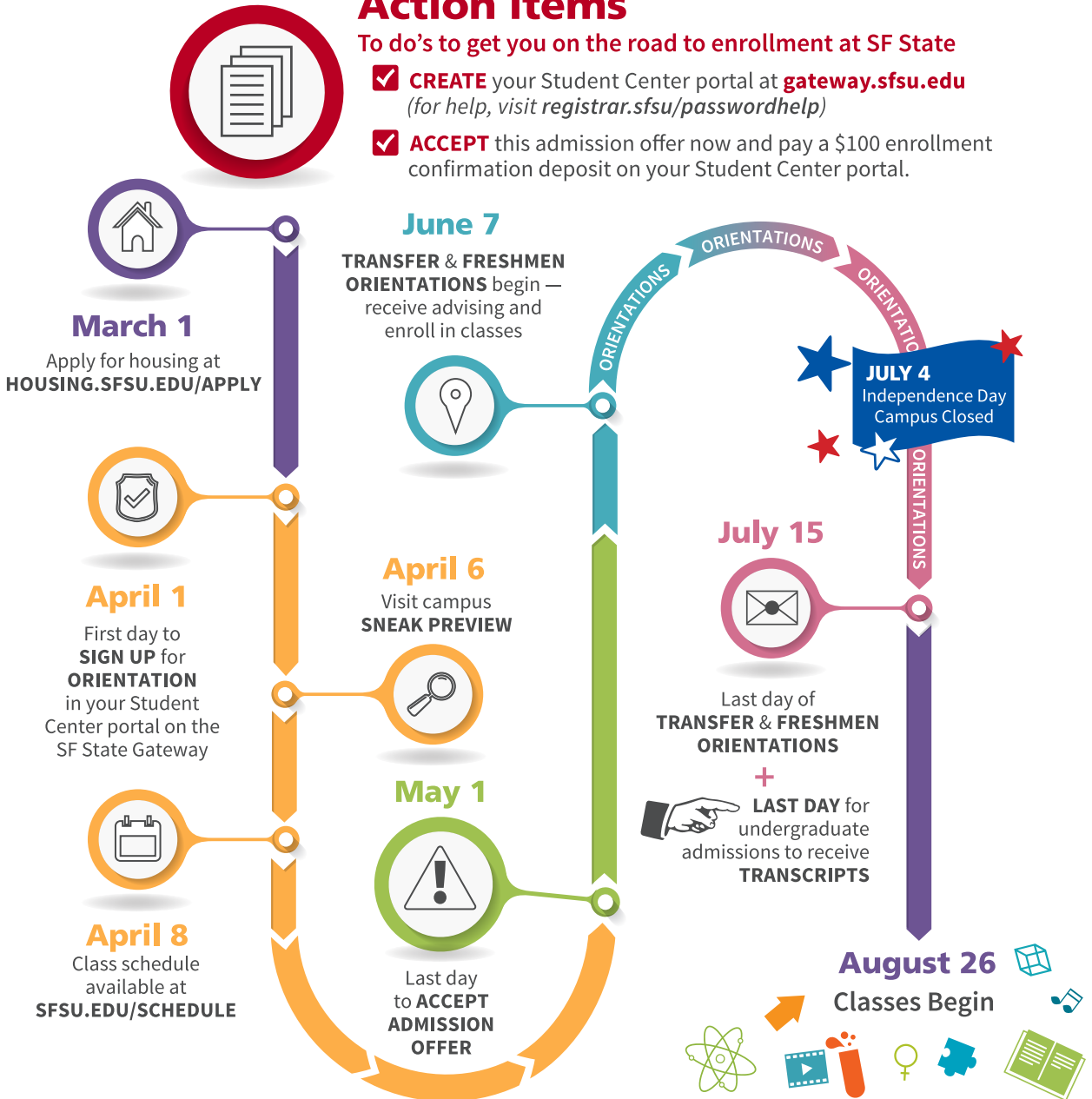
To determine your first semester English class, complete the Write to Register application at writetoregister.sfsu.edu before your orientation date or, if not attending, before your registration date.

Campus Housing

Whether you are a freshman, transfer or grad student, there are a variety of housing options at San Francisco State University, all with abundant cultural and social activities to enrich your life as you pursue your academic goals. And, research shows, you may even get better grades.

How to obtain housing at SF State

- Set up your Student Center portal at gateway.sfsu.edu.
- **Accept** this admission offer (AAO) to San Francisco State on your Student Center portal.
- **Apply** for campus housing March 1-31, 2019, at housing.sfsu.edu/apply. Housing is awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, and completing the application process by March 31 increases your chance to obtain housing. If you miss this priority deadline, your application and initial payment must be received no later than May 15, 2019.
- Confirmation of housing will be sent via email beginning in April 2019. If on-campus housing is at capacity when your application is received, waitlist notifications will be sent between June and October 2019.
- Building, room, space and roommate information will be sent via email one month prior to move-in day (end of August).

How to apply

- 1 Go to housing.sfsu.edu/apply and click on the **Apply Now** button.
- 2 Log into the housing portal using your SF State ID# (listed on acceptance letter) and password.
- 3 Fill out the application and License Agreement and click to **Accept the Terms**.
- 4 Pay the required initial payment through the University online payment page.

March 1 - March 31, 2019

Priority period for completing housing applications for the academic year 2019-2020.

May 15, 2019

Applications and initial payment must be received by this date for you to be considered for housing.

Financial Aid & Scholarships

As a student at SF State, you're making an investment in your future. Research shows that those with college degrees earn more throughout their lifetimes than those without. With good planning, an education at SF State can be accessible and affordable.

How to apply for financial aid

1 File a 2019–20 free application for **Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** at **fafsa.gov** between now and March 2, 2019. In the “Colleges to Receive Information” section of the application, select “San Francisco State University,” school code: 001154. If you're an undocumented student, file instead a **California Dream Act Application** at **dream.csac.ca.gov** for state and school financial aid.

2 If you're a California resident or eligible for in-state tuition under AB540, make sure your GPA has been submitted for a Cal Grant (in addition to the FAFSA or California Dream Act Application). Download the **Cal Grant GPA Verification Form** or the **Non-SSN GPA Verification Form** (*undocumented students*) for Cal Grants at **csac.ca.gov** and submit it to the California Student Aid Commission.

What happens next?

Here's what you should do to keep the financial aid process on track:

- Frequently **check** your email for document requests and award notices.
- **Respond** immediately to all requests for follow-up documents and financials, including those from both the SF State financial aid and admissions offices.

- Make sure you **accept** your financial aid offer on your Student Center portal at **gateway.sfsu.edu** or through the SF State mobile app.
- **Apply again next year!** You'll need to apply for financial aid every year you're enrolled at SF State to continue receiving aid. (Even if you didn't receive financial aid one year, you may be eligible to receive financial aid the next year.)

Scholarships 101

Begin your scholarship search with the SF State scholarship website at **financialaid.sfsu.edu/scholarships** for more than 700 campus and external scholarship opportunities, essay-writing tips and helpful links. You must apply for each scholarship separately based on eligibility requirements.
